

Health & Safety – Fire Warden Course

WHO	Those personnel appointed as Fire Wardens (or emergency wardens) and other persons (such as Health & Safety Representatives) who are required to attend appropriate training to ensure a safe workplace exists.
WHAT	This course provides the knowledge and skills that are necessary to perform the role and duties of a workplace Fire Warden (or an Emergency Warden).
WHY	Formal training will ensure personnel appointed as Fire Wardens in your workplace can respond to workplace emergencies and equip them with the knowledge, confidence and skills necessary for safe fire emergency control and evacuation of your workplace.
