In order to fulfil the functions as a Health and Safety Representative, those fulfilling that important role should complete the necessary training and keep informed of:

- the legal requirements relating to the health and safety of persons at work;
- particular hazards in the workplace and appropriate measures to eliminate or minimise them; and
- the health and safety policy of your employer, including arrangements for making sure that this policy is put into effect
