

## Health & Safety Representative Initial Training Course

Training In Supply (TIS) offer training designed exclusively for the logistics industries, including health and safety training for Health and Safety Representatives, supervisors and managers, including accident and incident investigation.

The Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (HSWA) has a key theme of requiring and encouraging communication with workers to improve workplace health and safety (HS). A safe workplace is more easily achieved when everyone involved in the work communicates with each other to identify hazards and risks, talk about any HS concerns and work together to find solutions.

The HSWA introduced the requirement for all new Health and Safety Representatives (HSR) to complete “initial” training and achieve NZQA unit standard 29315. This new course addresses this requirement and the relationships of HSR with Persons Conducting a Business or Undertaking (PCBU), plus the powers under the HSWA for HSR.

This course supplements our introductory HSR course and is offered for new HSR as a second one day module. This course can be completed either as a consecutive second day to the HSR introductory course, or as a separate one day course within a month of completing that course. For HSR who have previously completed the introductory course, completing this new course will give them the powers of new HSR as provided for in the HSWA.
