

Health & Safety – Managing Health and Safety

Training In Supply (TIS) offer training designed for the logistics related industries, including health and safety training for Health & Safety Representatives, supervisors and managers, including accident and incident investigation.

The Health and Safety at Work Act 2015 (the HSWA) aims to promote the health and safety of everyone at work and of other people in or around places of work. To achieve this, the HSWA requires people who are responsible for work and those who do the work to take steps to ensure their own health and safety and that of others.

- The HSAW Act, an overview
- The roles of Employees, Health & Safety Representatives (HSRs), Managers and Directors
- The Health & Safety processes within the organisation, and staff participation

- ACC levies and their impacts, ACC WSMP and WSD - requirements and benefits
- Health & Safety team management, Key Performance Indicators and reporting

Health & Safety Representative - Stage 3: Managing Health & Safety Course

WHO	Those with a managerial or supervisory responsibility for HSRs, “persons conducting a business or undertaking” (PCBUs), and experienced HSRs.
WHAT	The course is pitched at those having a managerial or supervisory role who perhaps seek a deeper understanding of compliance with the current legislation, or require an overview prior to committing their time to other training. The course will extend knowledge and skills to assist in developing and maintaining an effective workplace health and safety culture.
WHY	The legislation details the responsibilities of PCBU, recognising that they have a primary duty of care to ensure the health and safety of workers and others (who may not be employees) affected by work carried out by the PCBU. How does this affect you? What do you have to do to comply with the legislation? What are your liabilities for any non-compliance?
